# JEREMIAH PEREST

Prophets are very special men that were chosen by God before the world was ever formed. They were brought into existence to speak God's Holy Word. Many prophets were spoken of in the Bible hundreds of years before they were even born, like Moses, John the Baptist, our Lord Jesus, and even Brother Branham.


"A prophet is born a prophet. Every prophet that was ever in the world was born a prophet."

There was one prophet named Jeremiah who was a mighty man of God, like all of God's prophets. When Jeremiah was just a child, God said to him, "Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, and I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations." Jeremiah said that he could not speak, because he was just a child, but God told him not to say that. He was told he would go wherever God sent him and to say whatever God commanded. Jeremiah was becoming a prisoner. He may have been scared, but God said not to be afraid, because He was with him.

Jeremiah obeyed God, and did exactly as God told him. The hand of the LORD touched Jeremiah's mouth, and God set him over nations and kingdoms to speak the Words He had given. He told the people, kings, and priests to follow the commandments of God, but they would not listen. Instead they threw him in dungeons and prisons. But Jeremiah didn't care. He had already become a prisoner for Christ. He still went right on preaching the Word of God, and God was with him through it all, just as He promised.

Did you know that one time they took Jeremiah and lowered him down into a dungeon of mire (mud/clay) with cords, and left him there to die? The Lord used a Eunuch to rescue him







Paul found himself alone in a cold, depressing prison cell, but it didn't seem to bother him. You see, Paul had already made himself a prisoner long before he wound up in that dirty prison chamber. Years ago, he willingly gave up all the freedoms of this world; he sacrificed all that he had, and made himself a prisoner for Jesus Christ.

Could you imagine walking right up to a prison and saying, "Here I am, I want you to take my freedom away from me, and make every decision for me from now

on!" You would be giving up everything: your friends, your toys, even your family. That's exactly what Paul did; once he met Jesus, he became a prisoner to God's will. He didn't make decisions on his own anymore; he didn't go anywhere that God didn't want him to go, or say anything God didn't want him to say.

"God is looking for prisoners."


Do you think you could do that? Would you be able to say, "God, I want to ask You before I do anything," then listen for His answer and obey it, even if it's not what you wanted to hear?

Paul had to make these types of sacrifices, and in some ways it was really hard. He learned that if he only listened to God's Voice, everything worked out perfectly. That's why he wasn't scared or depressed when he was in prison; he knew that he had listened to God, and there was a purpose for him being stuck in that awful place.

Brother Branham said, "God is looking for prisoners." (63-0717) Do you want to become a prisoner for Christ, just like Paul? You can. Brother Branham also said, "If you are following God and have submitted yourself to God, then you become a prisoner to that God, to that Word, to that will. No matter what anything else says, you become a-a prisoner to It." (63-0717)

So next time you are wondering what decision you should make, just remember that it is not your decision, it's God's. Ask Him what you should do. Make yourself a prisoner for Christ.
